MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Please complete a membership form and bring to the Community Pavilion or the Oak View Center with the appropriate documentation. Forms can be downloaded at www.olparks.com or picked up at the Community Pavilion or the Oak View Center.

Return membership form, along with:

- Have current vaccinations or titers (antibodies) for: Rabies, Distemper, Hepatitis, Para influenza, Parvovirus, Leptospirosis and Bordetella (kennel cough)
- Have a stool specimen test for internal parasites
- Make check payable to: "Oak Lawn Park District"
- Dog Park Fees are non-refundable
- Signed Release of Liability form

Fee is per household not per dog – maximum of 3 dogs (Village of Oak Lawn household limit):

Resident - 1 year - \$50
Non Resident - 1 year - \$100

The membership ID's must be worn by the dog owner and visible at all times inside the dog park. Users found without proper membership ID will be asked to leave and may forfeit future park privileges.
