As a lasting gift, memorial, or to commemorate a special person or occasion, you can contribute to the Memorial Tree or Tree to a Tee Planting Programs. This fund is maintained by the Oak Lawn Parks Foundation for the planting of trees by the Oak Lawn Park District to beautify parks and the golf course. You may purchase a tree for \$275. Trees will be planted in the fall and Spring. Every effort will be made to honor the request of your choice of trees and park or golf course location of where it is to be planted. All contributions are tax deductible.
