Registration for all Summer Day Camps will begin on March 1, 2012.

(with the exception of Broadway Jr. - registration will begin May 7, 2012)

Youth Day Camp (entering 1st grade – 5th grade)

Don't miss out on the action! Enjoy a full day of excitement as we play games, sports, arts and crafts, special events and visitors; swim at least once a week and go on some fun field trips.

Before/Extended Day Camp (entering 1st grade – 5th grade)

Campers participating in Youth Day Camp have the opportunity to sign up for extended hours. This program will be held at the Oak View Center from 7-8:45am and 2-6pm. Campers will be bussed from their day camp site to Oak View, where parents are responsible to pick them up. No transportation is provided for Before Camp – must register at the Oak View camp site if you need the Before Camp as well.

Preschool Camp Sunshine

Your child will have a blast here! Each day something new and exciting happens. Camp Sunshine is filled with arts and crafts, games, songs, nature walks, special guests and events. This is a great experience to prepare children for their upcoming Fall preschool programs. All children must be potty trained! Sign up early, spaces fill quickly

Sports Camp (age 3rd grade – 8th grade)

Do you love playing sports? Then Sports Camp at the Community Pavilion is for you! You will receive specialized instruction as you play a variety of familiar sports activities: softball, floor hockey and kickball, just to name a few. Many sports and games will be introduced for your enjoyment. Emphasis will be placed on sportsmanship, teamwork, character development, leadership skills, overall physical fitness improvement, and most important, FUN! Choose from 1-, 2-, or 3- session options to fit your schedule. Activities may be played indoors or outdoors, so please dress appropriately pending weather conditions. You must provide your own sack lunch daily. Bus transportation is available, but space is limited.

Mini-Sports Camps (age 3rd grade – 8th grade)

This is the shortened version of Sports Camp. The structure and the activities of the camp will be the same as Sports Camp, but children will be enrolled fewer days per week and their daily camp will be fewer hours.

NEW Before & After Extended Sports Camp (age 3rd grade – 8th grade)

Participants of the full day and mini sports camp have the opportunity to SIGN UP FOR EXTENDED HOURS. The program will be held from 7-8:30am and 2:30pm until 6:00pm at the Oak Lawn Pavilion.

Special Recreation Full Day Camp (age 3-16)

Day Camp is designed for children with learning disabilities, behavior disorders, mental retardation, developmental disabilities or physical disabilities. Camp activities include sports, games, arts & crafts, swimming and field trips. Staff trained to handle children with special needs will supervise camp. Children will need to bring a lunch and drink to camp everyday. Limited transportation available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Special Recreation Half-Day Camp (age 8-20)

This day camp is for children who are in summer special-education classes. Camp will be held directly after summer school each day. Camp activities include sports, games, arts & crafts, and swimming. Staff trained to handle children with special needs will supervise camp. Children will need to bring a lunch and drink to camp everyday. Depending on summer school location, children will stay at their school for the afternoon or are bused by Rich Lee Bus Co. to camp locations. This will be arranged with the summer school teachers.

Pride Half-Day Camp (1st grade- 6th grade)

This camp is for children who attend Pride School Summer School. Camp will be held directly after school. Camp includes swimming, bowling, tennis, ice-skating and other activities. Children will need to bring a lunch and drink to camp everyday. Transportation will be arranged and provided by the school. Staff that is trained to handle children with behavior disorders will supervise camp.

Camp Discovery (age 18 & up) (Both 1/2 & Full Day Available)

This new camp is going to be designed for the more mature crowd. If you love spending time doing activities out in the community, hanging out with nature, and enjoying time with good friends, this camp is for you. Children will need to bring a lunch and drink to camp everyday. Camp activities will include: community exposure, awareness, and education along with crafts, field trips, and swimming
