



Pool Rules:

- No running
- No masks that cover the nose – goggles are allowed
- No floats – unless it is not crowded and the manager approves it
- One person on the diving board at a time; the person waiting in line must have both feet on the floor (“wait at the bottom”; the person who jumped off the board must exit from the ladder; the next person must wait till that person is at the ladder before jumping off.)
- No double bouncing on the board and no hanging from rail and swinging feet (“keep you feet on the board”)
- No jumping in backwards from side of pool
- No spinning while jumping into the pool
- No running to jumping into the pool
- No diving from the side of the pool
- No playing catch with a ball if it is crowded – must have manager’s approval
- One person on the slide at a time; person waiting must wait at the bottom of the slide until the person in front is off the slide
- Water wings are not allowed in the pool at all – never; it is a false sense of security for the child and parent. (They are allowed in the baby pool.) Lifejackets and swimsuits with panels in them are allowed
- No food consumption beyond the concession deck – not on sun deck; locker rooms; poolside.
- No one is to be on the shoulders or back of another person.
- No one is to swim under the rope, hang on the rope and tug on the rope.
