I hereby acknowledge that I voluntarily have applied to participate and use, with my dog(s), the Oak Lawn Park District Dog Park ("OLPDDP"). I understand that the act of unleashing my dog(s) and being physically present inside the "OLPDDP" necessarily involves risks of injury to me, other people, my dog(s) and other dogs, which risks are entirely my responsibility. I expressly assume all these risks. I further understand that dogs, irrespective of their training and usual past behavior of characteristics, may act or react unpredictably at times based upon instinct of circumstances, and I agree to assume that this risk may result from aggressive, vicious and dangerous dogs, which may be present in the "OLPDDP". I further understand and assume the risk that not all dogs present in the "OLPDDP" have received the Rabies vaccineas required by law and that not all dogs using the "OLPDDP" have been vaccinated for Distemper or Parvo all of which could result in injury to me and my dog(s). Additional risks include, but are not limited to: dog fights, dog bites and injuries to humans and other dogs; dog theft or unlawful capture; dog escape over or under fences; plants and/or water sources in the park may be poisonous to dogs; park vegetation may have burrs or seeds that could become tangled in a dog's coat or lodge in a dog's feet, ears, nose or eyes; mosquitoes, ticks, chiggers, fleas or other insects may be present; wild animals such as skunks, raccoons, opossums, or stray dogs could be present in the park, all of which might injure or infect your dog(s). I understand and expressly assume all additional risks. It is my understanding that no agent or employee of OAK LAWN PARK DISTRICT will supervise the "OLPDDP" at any time. I further understand that OAK LAWN PARK DISTRICT assumes NO liability for loss, damage or any kind of injury sustained by any human or dog wile using the "OLPDDP". I therefore expressly assume all risks associated with using the "OLPDDP", as well as fixtures and equipment located therein, in an unsupervised manner. By signing this release of liability and using the "OLPDDP", I hereby fully and forever release and discharge OAK LAWN PARK DISTRICT, their employees and agents from any and all claims, demands, damages, rights of action, or causes of action present or future, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of my use or intended use of said "OLPDDP" premises, facilities or equipment. I fully and forever release and discharge the OAK LAWN PARK DISTRICT and their employees and agents from any and all negligent acts and omissions in the same, and intended to be legally bound by this release. I have carefully read this release of liability and understand and fully agree with its contents. I also have received a copy of the rules for use for dog owners and thoroughly understand that dogs which display aggressive behavior will permanently lose membership privileges. I hereby certify that I have either homeowner or renters insurance with liability coverage.

REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP

To complete your membership registration owners must provide a current county registration form (or other proof of rabies vaccination), and proof of current vaccinations for distemper, kennel cough as well as proof of a fecal test for internal parasites. Please complete this membership form and bring to the Community Pavilion or the Oak View Center with the appropriate documentation.

Return this form, along with:

- One time submission of spayed or neutered dog certificate or letter from Vet.
- Have current vaccinations or titers (antibodies) for:
Rabies, Distemper, Hepatitis, Para influenza, Parvovirus, Leptospirosis and Bordetella (kennel cough)
- Have a stool specimen test for internal parasites
- Make check payable to: "Oak Lawn Park District"
- Dog Park Fees are non-refundable
- Signed Release of Liability form

Fee is per household not per dog – maximum of 3 dogs (Village of Oak Lawn household limit):

Resident - 1 year - \$50	Resident - 2 year - \$85
Non Resident - 1 year - \$100	Nonresident 2 year - \$170

The membership ID's must be worn by the dog owner and visible at all times inside the dog park. Users found without proper membership ID will be asked to leave and may forfeit future park privileges.

DOG PARK RULES

1. Membership ID's must be worn by the dog owner and visible at all times inside the dog park. Dog Park membership passes are available at the Community Pavilion, 9401 South Oak Park Avenue, Oak Lawn and the Oak View Center, 4625 W. 110th Street.
2. SCOOP THE POOP. Use the disposal bags available. Park Ordinances require owner/handler clean up and properly dispose of waste left by their dog(s).
3. Dogs must be kept on leash until they are in the dog park entrance and the gate has closed behind them. Do the reverse when leaving. For the safety of your pet as well as others, DO NOT keep your dog on leash while in the park.
4. Dog owner/handlers must be physically capable of controlling their dog. All owner/handlers are required to remain inside the off-leash area and be in view of their dog(s) at all times. The limit is three(3) dogs per handler, per visit.
5. Aggressive dogs are not permitted on the premises. Dogs exhibiting rough, aggressive or dangerous behavior must be leashed and removed by owner/handler immediately.
6. Excessive barking is prohibited. Dogs barking excessively must be removed by owner/handler.
7. All dogs must be current on all vaccinations. Vaccination expiration dates can be found on membership ID's
8. All dogs must be licensed by their respective municipality and display said license/tag while in the dog park. Non-residents must have the current rabies vaccine tag as well as a dog license tag issued by the governing body where they reside.
9. Owners must fill any holes their dog(s) dig.
10. The off-leash dog park is for dogs and their handlers. No other TYPE of animal (i.e. hunting or other use) is allowed. No firearms, starting pistols are permitted.
11. Absolutely no female dogs in heat or puppies under the age of six (6) months are allowed in the park.
12. No smoking, food, alcoholic beverages, glass containers, strollers, or bicycles are allowed inside the dog park.
13. Children under 15 years old must be accompanied and supervised closely by an adult at all times. It is recommended that small children not be brought into the off leash area. Children are not permitted to run with or chase, dogs.
14. Users of the dog park do so at their own risk. Oak Lawn Park District is not liable for any injury or damage caused by any dog or person in this park. Owners and Users agree to assume the full responsibility of any injuries, damages, or loss to themselves, their dogs or property or any damage to other people or dogs connected with or associated with their use of the park.
15. All users must immediately obey verbal or written orders of Park Employees. Please be reminded that failure to comply with park rules or to maintain the facility in a clean or orderly fashion will result in fines or temporary/permanent loss of park privileges.
16. Only flying discs and tennis balls are allowed to be thrown inside the dog park.
17. All Park Ordinances apply. Enforced by Oak Lawn Park District and/or Oak Lawn Police Department.
18. The Oak Lawn Park District reserves the right to revoke membership privileges.
