Dear Parent(s),

Welcome to Sport's Camp! Here are a few things you may need to know about our program.

Many of our activities take place outdoors. Hats and sunscreen are highly recommended. Be sure to bring a non-perishable snack and sack lunch along with a swimsuit and towel on a daily basis. **In order to swim, campers must wear a swimsuit.** We will be using Centennial Pool everyday, unless the sport's camp is on a field trip, a special guest, or there is inclement weather. We will be going on field trips during both first and second sessions of camp. There will be **2** field trips per session. All money and permission slips for field trips must be turned in by the deadline. Anyone who turns in his or her permission slip late **may not be able to attend.** If your child is not attending the field trip, he or she will **not have camp that day.** There are possibilities we may go on mini-field trips at no extra cost, which may include ice-skating, or miniature golf at the golf course.

If your child is asthmatic and uses an inhaler, please make sure your child notifies the counselors, and carries the inhaler with them.

Please do not send your child to Sport's Camp any earlier than 8:15 a.m. The counselors use the time before camp to set up and plan activities for the day. They cannot also supervise campers.

Camp ends for all campers at 2:30 p.m. **All children should be picked up at 2:30 p.m.** If someone other than a parent or persons listed on the emergency form is picking up your child, we must have a written note from the parent. We will not release a child to an unauthorized person.
