While the Oak Lawn Park District is excited to offer a summer camp program this summer we understand that the program we are offering does not include all of our past camp participants. Please understand that we look forward to more inclusive guidelines in the future.

Eligibility for participation:

Due to continued restrictions for safety there are specific eligibility requirements campers must meet in order to attend camp this summer. Staff will assess each camper's ability to participate in camp while following these guidelines. Staff will continue to assess each camper's ability as needed throughout camp. At any point if a camper cannot follow these guidelines, staff will reassess their eligibility for camp.

- · Ability to participate in camp activities with minimal visual and verbal prompting.
- · Ability to adapt to changes in camp schedule.
- Ability to independently attend to personal care (i.e. toileting, feeding, hygiene, hand over hand, lifting/transferring, and hand washing/using sanitizer). Staff will assist with verbal prompting, if needed.
- · Ability to be responsible for own personal items with verbal prompts or reminders.
- · Ability to stay in safe proximity to group and refrain from elopement or wandering.
- Ability to refrain from physically aggressive behaviors such as biting, spitting, scratching, hitting, kicking, etc. or behaviors that require direct or close proximity intervention from staff.

If you answered "Yes" to all the statements above, you are eligible for Summer Day Camp. If you answered "No" to any of the statements above, you will not be eligible for Day Camp this summer. If you have any questions about eligibility, please contact Jacqueline Canty at jcanty@olparks.com

Important Information:

- A minimum of 15% of the total camp fees is due at the time of registration (no exceptions) to hold your camper's spot.
- The registration deadline for the 2023 Special Recreation Camps is Friday, May 26th. NO registrations for camp will be accepted after that date due to staffing requirements.
- Both full day & half day camps begin on Monday, June 12th.
- ALL brand new campers must have an in-person assessment meeting with the day camp director & the Special Recreation Supervisor (J. Canty) before the start of camp. You will be contacted by J. Canty to set up the meeting AFTER you enroll your camper in the program.
- Each camper must have a parent/caretaker/guardian attend our Camp Informational sessions. It will be held at the Dream Center NOT the Oak View Center from 6-7pm on Wednesday, June 7th. This informational session is for your benefit. ALL of the camps policies, procedures, schedules, and questions will be reviewed & answered.
- ALL camp registration fees must be paid for by Monday, June 5th for your camper to participate in the 2023 camp season. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- · Each camper must bring a labeled, non-perishable lunch & water bottle daily.
- On swim days, each camper must bring a labeled bathing suit, towel & sunblock (spray is preferred).
- Once a camper is enrolled for camp, fees will not be adjusted or refunded due to vacation time, planned absences, suspension or expulsion of camp program, etc.
- For summer programming for adults with disabilities ages 18 & up, look out for the summer program guide!
