FLASH is proud to be Ridgeland School District 122 & Oak Lawn Hometown School District 123's Before & After School Program! Our program serves children in grades Kindergarten through 8th Grade and we accommodate a variety of schedules with flexible payment options.

A typical day at the program will include structured, age-appropriate activities, arts & crafts, free play, an opportunity to do homework and an afternoon snack. Staff is always on hand to supervise, lead activities, assist with homework, help resolve conflict and communicate with parents. (dh)

4 Year Old Pre-School: We are willing to work with families with children in 4 year old pre-school. FLASH is NOT present during the school day, but we are willing to offer childcare in the morning from 7:00am-until the start of the regular school day, or from regular school dismissal until 6:30pm.

DAYS OFF & BREAK CAMPS: On most school days off & holiday breaks The FLASH Program offers a 6:45am to 6:30pm program. On these days we typically take the children on a field trip and spend the rest of the day at the Oak Lawn Park District Community Pavilion. Costs are separate from monthly tuition. FLASH will host 4 camps throughout the school year during extended breaks. These include: Fall Break, Winter Break, Spring Break & Summer Break Camps. Information for these days will be distributed in monthly newsletters and will be available on our website.

SNACKS: We provide healthy snacks to give kids the nutrients and energy they need to keep their bodies running strong and smart. Snack is served in the afternoon only. Parents are welcome to send children to the program with breakfast and additional snacks.

PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES: Daily indoor and outdoor activities offer endless ways for the children to get physical exercise, socialize and have fun!

HOMEWORK: Every day we will encourage the children to work on homework. Our staff will be on hand to assist the children, if needed.

T-SHIRT: FREE yearly t-shirt for all participants. Additional shirts are available for \$5 per shirt.

MONTHLY NEWSLETTERS: Newsletter will be provided monthly with important program information, updates and other park district news.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT INFORMATION

HOW TO REGISTER

Registration for the 2021-2022 School Year is currently being accepted.

REGISTRATION CODES:

REGISTRATION FEE: \$55 per family.

*Registration Fee is not refundable. Once you register, you are registered for the entire school year. You MUST re-register every school year.

ON SITE Registration paperwork is available at the Community Pavilion, 9401 S. Oak Park Ave. or Oak View Center, 4625 W. 110th St.

DROP OFF: Completed paperwork must be turned in to the park district with the registration fee before your child can begin the program.

FLASH requires at least 2 business days notice before your child can start the program. Payment amount will be determined by your child's start date and schedule at the program.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

Your monthly payments are based on your schedule and school days in the calendar month. Please be aware that your monthly payment will change from month to month based on the amount of school days in that month. Payments are run the first of the month.

Calculate your monthly payment: (Days your child is attending for the Calendar Month) X (Rate) = Monthly Payment

Payments will be automatically deducted from your credit/bank account, through direct debit.

Your first tuition payment will be due your 1st week of FLASH.

DAILY FEES:

Morning: \$9 • Afternoon: \$16 • Full Day: \$19

DIRECT DEBIT

Parents will be set up on the Direct Debit payment method. Your payment will be automatically withdrawn the 1st of every month or on the 1st & 15th of every month.

PUNCH CARD

For parents with an unpredictable schedule we offer prepaid Punch Cards. If you don't know when or how often you will need FLASH you may purchase a punch card instead of committing to a schedule. When your child attends FLASH the card is punched and when your run out of days you are required to purchase another card before your child can return. **Parents MUST alert the FLASH staff and their child's school when their child will be attending the program.** Punch Cards can be purchased from your child's site director. **FLASH REQUIRES 24 HOURS NOTICE WHENEVER YOUR CHILD WILL ATTEND THE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM.**

Punch Card Rates:

5 Mornings: \$55 5 Afternoons: \$90 10 Mornings: \$110 10 Afternoons: \$180

FLASH Fall Break Camp (Age: K-8th Grade)

Your child does not need to be a FLASH program participant to register, but camp dates will base off Ridgeland District 122 and Oak Lawn Hometown District 123. The FLASH staff will be on hand to supervise, lead activities, and take the children on field trips.
