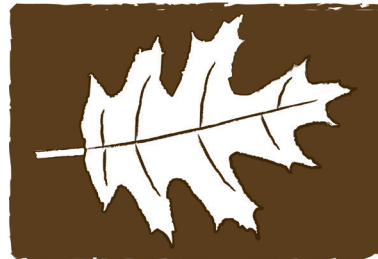

Donors

In order to become a tree donor, the form attached to this brochure must be completed and returned to the Oak Lawn Parks Foundation, 4625 W. 110th Street, Oak Lawn, IL 60453

Donors may purchase one tree for \$350.00. Checks should be made payable to the Oak Lawn Park District. All contributions are tax deductible.

Planting

Tree donors can request the specific park where they would like a tree planted. Donors may choose from any one of the park district parks; however, the Parks Foundation reserves the right to designate the site.

Tree Location

As a tree donor it is also possible to request a particular tree variety you would like to have planted. The Parks Foundation will do its best to meet your request.

Trees are planted twice a year in Spring and Fall. Donors are invited to meet with members of the Parks Foundation on that day for a tree planting ceremony. At that time, donors are presented with a certificate acknowledging their donation including the name of the person or event being commemorated. A permanent record is kept of the donor, the honoree, and the site of the planting.

Guarantee

All Memorial Tree Fund Trees are maintained by the Oak Lawn Park District. In the event the tree is damaged, it will be replaced by the Parks Foundation as funds permit.
