E.P.I.C. Junior Team (Age: 11-13 or tournament ready juniors) – **White, Yellow, & Orange Hat Level**

The E.P.I.C. Program introduces golfers to the finer instructional elements of the game. Players begin the program by being assessed in both their golf and fitness skills by a TPI Certified Coach. Then players learn the areas that will help them move up these assessments to better their abilities to practice deliberately at full swing, putting and short game. But also learn how to increase their mobility, speed and strength so they can continue further in the game as the grow. (ts)

E.P.I.C. Advanced Team (Age: 14 & up or already competing juniors) **Orange & Red Hat Level**

The E.P.I.C. Advanced program has been recognized nationally as a program that develops players to compete at the higher levels of junior golf. The program is a year-round program that evaluates the skills of each player and determines the area that will help them improve most. A plan is created and then worked on and the players works on implementing the plan in practice and then competition. Participants also will given a TPI Screen and assigned workouts to perform on their own time that will take their game to the next level. (ts)

E.P.I.C. Junior Series (Age:11-18)
