Private Piano Lessons (Age: 8 & up)

Students learn note reading, theory, rhythm, song improvisation, interpretation, composition, and transposing. Monday/Tuesday lessons will include 360 minutes of lessons given in increments of eight 45-minute sessions. Wednesday/Thursday lessons will include 300 minutes of lessons given in increments of ten half-hour or 5 hour-long lessons. 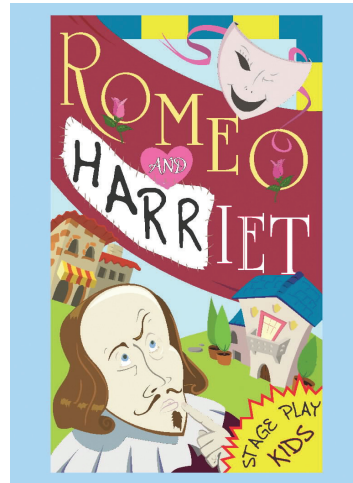
