



FLASH Program Punch Card FAQs

-Punch Cards are only "punched", or marked, on the days in which a child attends the program, that way you are not potentially paying for days that they are absent.

-Punch Cards can either be paid with the FLASH staff at the school itself with cash/check, OR with the FLASH Office with a card on file, whichever is more convenient for you 😊 Exact change is needed if paying with cash as the FLASH staff does not give out change at the school.

-The physical punch card stays at the school with the FLASH staff so they can keep track of it and mark it when the child comes; at any time, you are more than welcome to ask the FLASH staff how many punches you have left, to see the punch card itself, and even take a picture of it.

-Once a punch card is used up, a new one must be purchased to replace it for the child to attend the respective session (AM or PM) again.

-Punch Cards expire at the end of the current school year; AM Punch Cards can be used for Late Start Days, PM Punch Cards can be used for Half/Early Out Days.

-A single Punch Card may be shared between siblings; if, for example, both kids come on the same day, then staff will mark the same date twice on the Punch Card (one for each child).
